Business competition is now between supply networks rather than individual corporations. The certification tests for managerial ability in administration of the flow of products, information, and revenue across supply chains, which differentiates the ability of supply networks to fulfill customer needs.

Who is ACSCM® certification for?

ACSCM® examination tests your managerial capabilities in logistics, digital coordination for supply chain integration, inventory management, risk pooling, procurement, product and process design, and international supply chain management, including logistics, digital coordination of decisions and resources, inventory and risk management, procurement and supply contracting, product and process design, and revenue management.

The examination test members in major instructional areas in an advanced Procurement Management skills and explores the methods used by organizations to acquire the raw materials, components, supplies, equipment, facilities, and services needed to operate.

General Certification

Do I have to be a student member to apply for any of the AAPSCM® certifications?

No. You do not have to be a student member. However, you may register with any of our affiliate agents in your continent. We have agents in the GCC and middle eastern countries, Africa, Asia, North and South America. We also have agents in the Caribbean countries like Cuba, Jamaica or the Bahamas. You may also register online directly as a member and have a membership ID and pick the type of membership you are qualified for.

How do I earn anAAPSCM® certification?

To obtain any of our certifications, you must first meet the eligibility requirements outlined on these web pages and detailed in the certification handbooks. Then, you must pass an exam.

What are the eligibility requirements?

The eligibility requirements for each certification are mentioned on our website – www.aapscm.org and detailed in each respective certification handbook.

How do I complete the application?

All certification applications are available online on our website www.aapscm.org. Register for the membership you desire, pay the membership fee online and you will be sent your account information and unique ID to put you on the path to take the exam. You may also register with any of our affiliate training institute in your continent and get qualified with the 4-day training program

AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF PROCUREMENT What supporting documentation should I send with my application?

When submitting an application, you do not need to send documentation. However, you will be required to send supporting documentation if your application is selected for a random audit. To find out more about our AASCPM® audit process, refer to the certification handbooks and the audit FAQs.

Exam Guidance

Once I pass the exam or evaluations, what next?

You may refer to yourself as a certification holder. You will receive your digital badge through mail or directly mailed from our head office in South Carolina, USA to your agent. Your certification can be shared on social media and verified by employers. You will receive an ID card also with certified signature. Please refer to the "Use of Your AAPSCM®I Certification" section of the handbooks for more details.

How do I schedule a certification exam appointment?

Once you are eligible, AAPSCM® will e-mail you examination scheduling instructions with your eligibility code, which you will need when scheduling your exam appointment at a testing center or online.

Where will the examination be given?

All AAPSCM® exams are offered at approved affiliate agents location centers worldwide. The test is available at those locations and will be taken online using the agents approved computer systems. We are vendor-neutral and only accredited training centers can offer our exams

for information about exam availability in your area, email us directly at exams@aapscm.org or call us directly. A live person will answer your phone call.

You can also take your certifications exam in the comfort of your home or office while being monitored by an online proctor through our accredited agents

Are the exams available in languages other than English?

Our certification exams are all in US English. Your agent or any of our accredited agents may translate instructions or course materials to any language on their own but the examination itself will be in US English

If I fail the exam, can I take it again?

If you fail the exam on your first attempt, you can re-take it two more times within your one-year eligibility period. Fees are associated with re-examination. Details for re-examination can be found in the certification handbook.

What happens if my eligibility expires, and I have not taken the exam?
Your application is valid for one (1) year from the date of approval. If you allow your eligibility to lapse, you must re-apply.
